Band Camp

Band Camp will take place during two weeks in August. This time is an opportunity for the entire band and color guard to rehearse together and learn most of our music, choreography, flag work, and complex marching maneuvers for our show. Not only does this time allow students to grow as performers, but they learn to work together as a team. It is important for our group dynamic that we have full attendance and participation for these rehearsals! If you have a conflict with the band camp dates, please contact Ms. Sablan IMMEDIATELY.

*** Financial Obligation ***

A Financial Obligation Notification is included in the parent section of the contract. This agreement documents your understanding that not paying Band Fees will result in your information being provided to the HHS Financial Office for collection. Every student should have their Band Fees paid in full prior to the start of the season.

If you are unable to pay your Band Fees in full, we will assist you by putting you in contact with the school's Financial Assistance person. Student information for all uncollected Band Fees will be submitted to the Finance Office for collection.

Please note that a financial obligation can impact your child's Graduation and/or other school activities until the balance is paid in full. This policy has been reviewed and approved by Huntingtown High School Administration. Band Fee payments will still be accepted for those that

What do I need for band camp?

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE WITHOUT SIGNED HEALTH FORM AND/OR COMMITMENT CONTRACT.

PENCIL: All students are required to have pencils accessible at rehearsals for music notes and dot books.

Instrument: We will be playing during our first rehearsal session, so be prepared with your instrument in working order. Please see Ms. Sablan with any instrument questions you may have.

“Dot Book” (front ensemble exempt): A small spiral notebook, with lanyard or something to hang around neck, and a pencil – used to write down drill.

Athletic Shoes: Running type shoes are strongly recommended. Students want sneakers with support. Be sure to wear them in before camp. This is to prevent injury. Students may not march with flip flops/sandals, bare feet, boots, skate shoes, basketball shoes, or dress-type shoes. Kids without proper footwear will not participate until they have the correct shoes.

Thick Athletic Socks: This will avoid blisters during marching.

Baseball Hat/Sunglasses to protect your eyes and face – if desired. Make sure glasses have thin sides, don't want to have bulky glasses that affect your peripheral vision.

Athletic Shorts: This allows for comfort and visual confirmation that the feet and legs are in the appropriate configuration for drill movements.

T-Shirt: Please dress comfortably for the hot weather.

Dress appropriately for a school-based activity. The Student Code of Conduct can be used as a guide. If you have any questions about whether something is appropriate, please ask.

Water/Gatorade/Sports drinks: Students need to keep hydrated because we will be outside for many rehearsals. Water will be readily available, and students are required to bring personal water bottles. **Bring an insulated gallon water jug (Coleman-style) to keep water cool.** Some students also like to use a **camel back hydration device, but this is not required.** DO NOT bring or drink sodas and other sugar/caffeine filled drinks.

Sunscreen: Please protect your skin from the intense sun. Be prepared to apply multiple times during the day.

Towel: All wind instruments must use a towel to place instruments on when put down. This will protect your instruments!

Lunch: You must bring a healthy lunch and a drink. We will provide a cool spot to eat, relax, and socialize as a band. **Under no circumstances will students be allowed to leave the campus during band camp hours.**

Other Important Band Camp Information

Please do your best to consider the following points. We hope that these tips will help your transition into band camp and the marching season easier!

Hydrate, Hydrate, HYDRATE! It is in every member's best interest to begin hydrating BEFORE August 10! Make it a goal to start drinking water regularly starting at the beginning of August *at least*.

Go walking and STRETCH. If you are not used to incorporating exercise into your daily life, consider going for walks leading up to band camp. It is likely that each member will be taking 10,000 steps a day, so prepare yourself! If you would like to take it a step further and start running/bodyweight training, all the better. Do what is best for YOU.

Breakfast: Members MUST eat a nutritious meal before rehearsal each day. We will be working hard on the field, so make sure you eat to exercise!

Dinner: May be provided during the two weeks of band camp (from food/monetary fees/donations). We are currently working on a meal plan for band camp. **At no time will students be permitted to leave the campus during camp hours.** This is for both legal and practical reasons. Parents, you will be asked to help provide food items or funds needed to feed the students during band camp. If your student will not eat what is provided, you are responsible for bringing them dinner during our dinner hour.

Season Expectations and Considerations

As a marching band, we have many different responsibilities and roles throughout the school and state! Below are summaries of roles and expectations of our program.

After-school Rehearsals: At after-school rehearsals, we are working together to better our show as a group and as individuals. We will have roughly three rehearsals a week in the evenings in order to keep up with our skillsets.

Performance Show T-Shirt (included in band camp fees): Our theme show t-shirt must be worn under your uniform at all performances. Shirts will be given out prior to the first home football game. **Additional T-Shirts will be available for purchase.

Our Uniform: As a member of the band, you are representing our program. Any time you are wearing band attire, whether it is your full uniform or a show shirt, you are being recognized as a Marching Hurricane. You should be mindful and respectful when representing the Marching Hurricanes regardless of the situation before you. Hold yourself to higher expectations.

Competitions: YOU CANNOT MISS THIS EVENT WITHOU PERMISSION! In competition mode, our band is both serious and respectful. You are there to compete but also there to encourage the other bands around you. We are in a competitive circuit, and we will be looked up to for our behavior and our attitudes regardless of scores.

Football Games: YOU CANNOT MISS THIS EVENT WITHOUT PERMISSION! At Huntingtown football games, we are there to support the football team. Our goal is to keep the energy alive in the stands, so we will be standing cheering on the team. The more you can engage in the community, the more they will engage in you. We will do our best to be at EVERY varsity football game, including any playoff games.

Financial Obligations

Band Fee: A request was made by the majority of band parents to include as many band financial obligations as possible into one lump payment for convenience. This mandatory fee will be charged to each student to pay for professional instructor staff, equipment needs, some of the food and drinks, T-shirts, transportation, band booster dues, as well as the precision marching drill design, color guard choreography and musical arrangements for the competitive season.

The Band Camp Fee is as follows:

\$350.00 for winds, brass (includes a portion of the cost for equipment)

\$350.00 for color guard (includes a portion of the uniform expense)

\$350.00 for pit and drum line (includes a portion of the cost for equipment)

A **\$100.00 deposit must be paid at this time** to hold your child's spot in our show. Checks should be made out to the HHS Band. The payment schedule is as follows:

\$100.00 deposit (minimum): Due no later than Wednesday, June 1, 2022

\$100.00 payment (minimum): Due no later than Friday, July 1, 2022

Remaining payment in full: Due no later than Monday, August 8, 2022

ALL MARCHING BAND FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY

August 8, 2022

ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

Note: If the financial obligations cannot be met and/or you need payments to be extended, please contact Ms. Sablan for assistance. Please do not let this be a reason for not participating because help is available!

Additional Obligations:

Any lost or damaged uniform pieces will be replaced at the cost of the member responsible for the article.

Marching Shoes: Shoes will cost approximately \$50.00. A band booster representative will be measuring students for shoes. Please remember to bring performance THICK black socks with you during shoe fitting. This avoids complications with fittings. You may pay in advance for your child's shoes (recommended).

All wind/brass performers (except for percussion) must have 4 pair of black performance gloves. They are available for \$10.00 each and will be paid for when your child's fees are paid.

Color guard members must purchase leather gloves approx. \$25.00 each (style and color to be announced) and a flag bag approx. \$30.00 each their first year.

The national championship performance may be an overnight trip. Please note that the costs for this trip are NOT included in the established band fees. Once the details become available, they will be shared as soon as possible.

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MARCHING BAND COMMITMENT/CONTRACT

Marching band is an extra-curricular activity. Since marching band is not a required activity, students who choose to participate must commit to being on time to **ALL** rehearsals and performances. This will mean rearranging work schedules or other activities. Parents must ensure that students will be EARLY to all rehearsals and performances. Pulling up in the parking lot at rehearsal time is LATE for rehearsal. Unlike sports teams, there is no way of substituting for players who do not attend or do not perform up to standard. Failure to participate will be detrimental to the organization and will result in increased expenditures to pay the design team for drill revisions.

1.) Schedule

I have received the schedule of activities for the year, and I make the commitment to attend rehearsals and performances, as well as band camp.

2.) Preparation

I make the commitment to come to all rehearsals fully prepared, with my instrument in good working order, music, drill charts, dot book, pencil and all other necessary equipment. I will be dressed in appropriate clothing and running shoes. I will arrive to rehearsal with enough lead-time to be “on the field” at rehearsal time. **Pulling up in the parking lot at rehearsal time is LATE for rehearsal.**

3.) Financial Commitment

I understand that there is a financial component to join the Marching Band. Band fees and fundraisers are needed in order to fund our program. I will make every effort to fulfill this commitment in a timely fashion through payments, fundraising, or arrangements with the Director. **I understand that all funds paid toward “Band Fees” are non-refundable.**

4.) Attendance

I understand that attendance at all rehearsals and performances is mandatory, unless prior arrangements have been negotiated. The Band Director may make individual exceptions based on specific circumstances. I further understand that if I miss a rehearsal, I must make up the time and the material that was covered in the rehearsal in order to be eligible to participate in the next performance. **I must fill out an absence form prior to the date to be excused from a rehearsal or performance at the beginning of the season.** I have read, understand, and agree to the following attendance policy:

DEFINITIONS

Excused Absence: illness, death in the family

Un-excused Absence: work, homework, no ride, sleeping, etc.

SUMMER REHEARSALS: Students are expected to be at all summer rehearsals, but in the event of family vacations, college trips, etc. please keep open communication with the staff and student leadership about attendance.

BAND CAMP IS MANDATORY!

SEASON REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES:

*Excused absences may be granted on a case-by-case basis. Only Ms. Sablan can grant authorization. Conflicts must be communicated AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. Emergencies will be handled on an individual basis.

It is essential that no student is absent from a show or performance unless given explicit permission. An excused absence will only be dealt with in an extreme or emergent situation and will be determined by the director.

Unexcused absences must be made up in the form of alternative assignments from staff.

NOTIFICATION OF AN ABSENCE (other than illness) MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO MS. SABLAN PRIOR TO BAND CAMP.

One absence from rehearsal (excused or un-excused) may result in suspension from the marching band for the next performance.

These factors will be taken into consideration:

- a. What was the reason for the absence?
- b. Was the work or music learned and made up outside of practice and then prepared for the next rehearsal?
- c. Is the ensemble member able to do all the work needed for the performance?

I agree to the conditions stated above and further agree that should my attendance or behavior jeopardize the success of the group, the Director has the right to withdraw me from marching band.

I understand that participation in fundraising events is needed to fund our program and personal ventures.

Furthermore, I understand that as a parent and member of the Band Boosters, I will be required to volunteer within the Band Boosters organization to ensure a successful season of the HHS Marching Hurricanes Band. This may include, but is not limited to, helping at Band Camp, Football Games, Shows, Practices, and Fundraising activities/events.
